

## Argentine:

Waterfalls and national parks in the north; glaciers and snow-capped mountains in the south; Aconcagua, in the Andes Mountains is the highest peak in the western hemisphere; Mendoza's vineyards and wineries; estancias (ranches) on the pampas; the Lake Districts of Bariloche and Peuma-hué; numerous World Heritage Sites; nature and wildlife, particularly at Iguazú, Iberá and the Valdés Peninsula; historic towns, including Salta City, the country's best-preserved colonial city; Ushuaia, the world's southernmost city; and Buenos Aires, the nation's fascinating capital .
